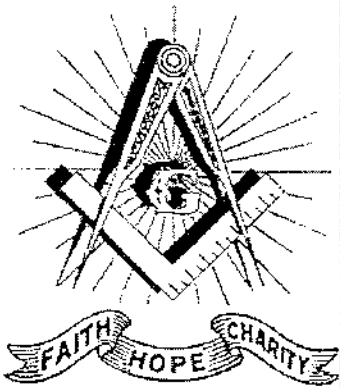

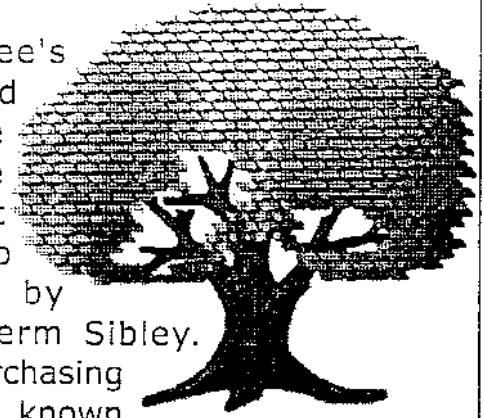

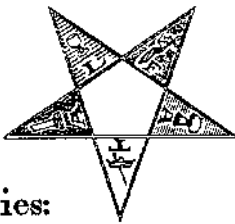

The Living Tree

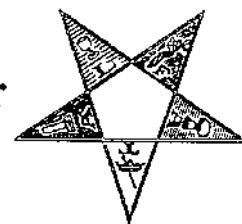

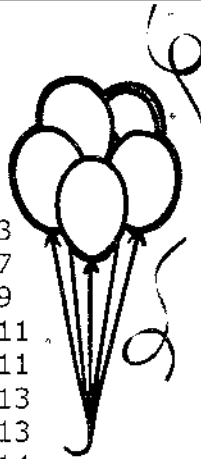

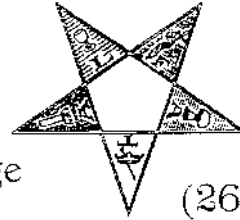
WHAT'S HAPPENING!

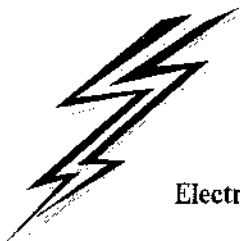

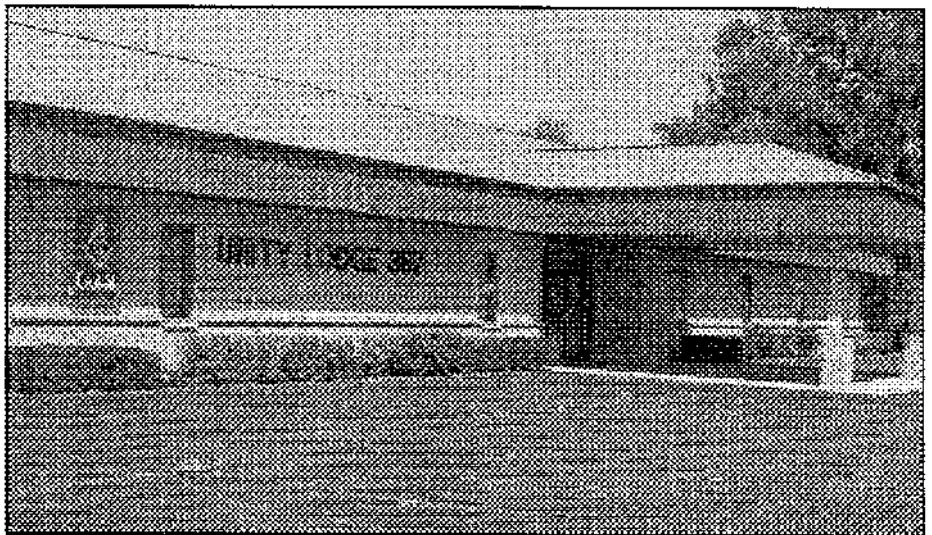
