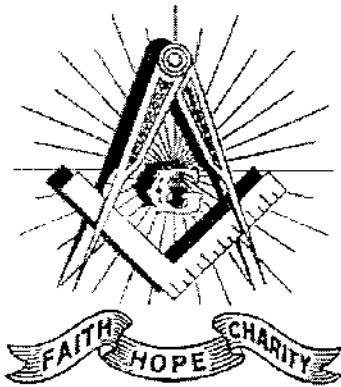

The Master's Words

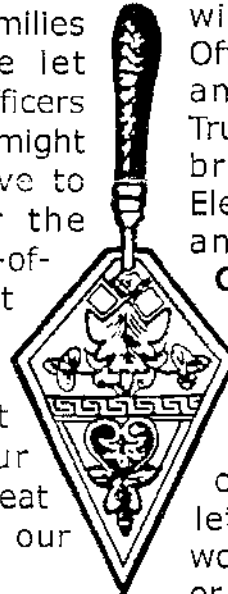
