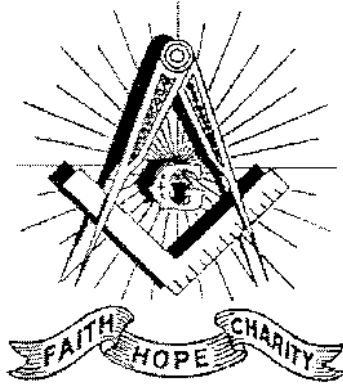

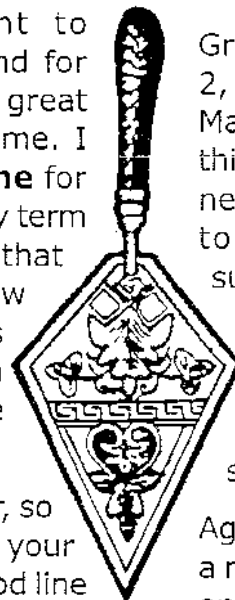

Now is the time, before your 2005 dues payment, to consider not what your Lodge can do for you, but, what can you do for your Lodge **Ad Infinitum !!!**

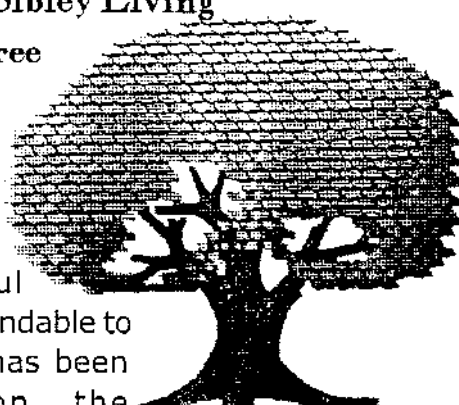
