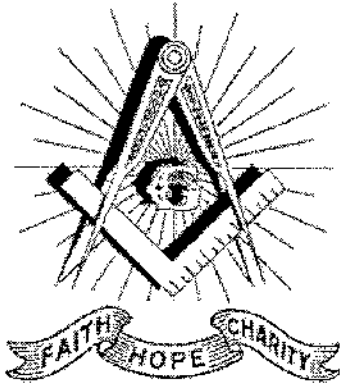

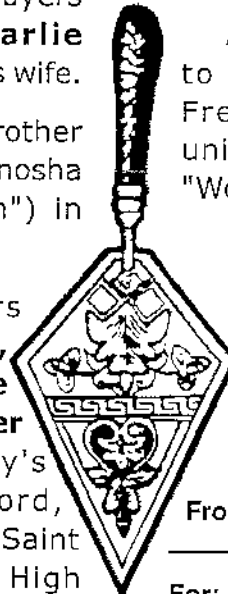
Grand Lodge was held in Madison on June 2nd and 3rd. Thanks to Brother **Gordon Charlton**, PM, for being my Proxie.

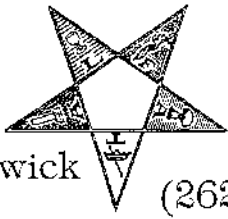
Please note that we will be having Initiation at one of these meetings as we welcome Robert Walker into our Chapter.

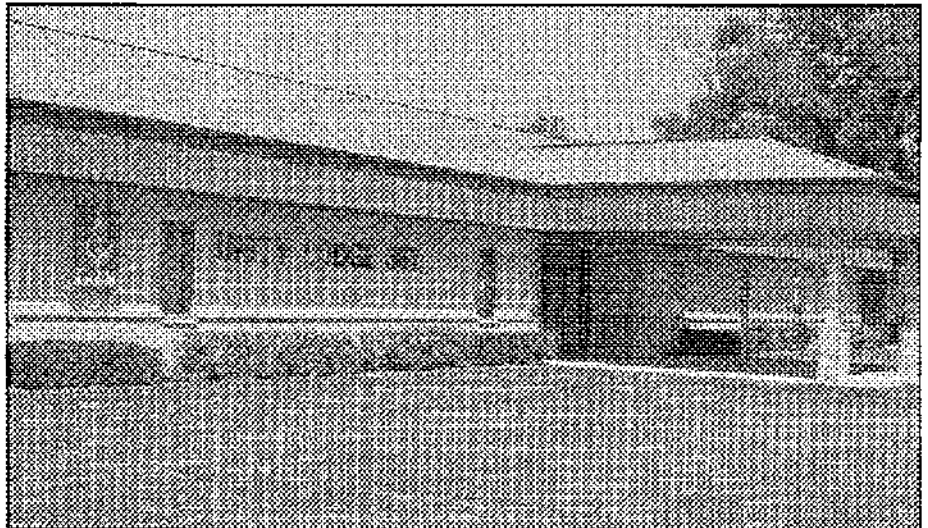
