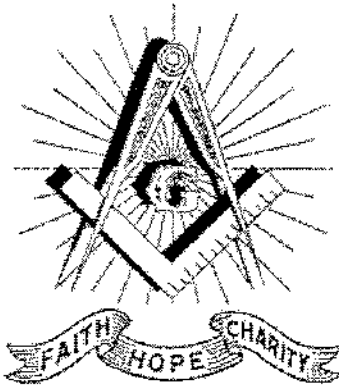

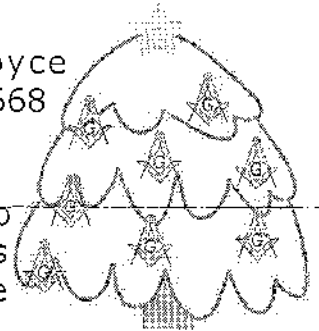

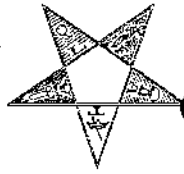

May you have a Blessed Christmas and a Happy and Prosperous 2007.

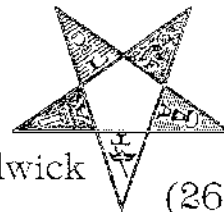

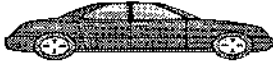

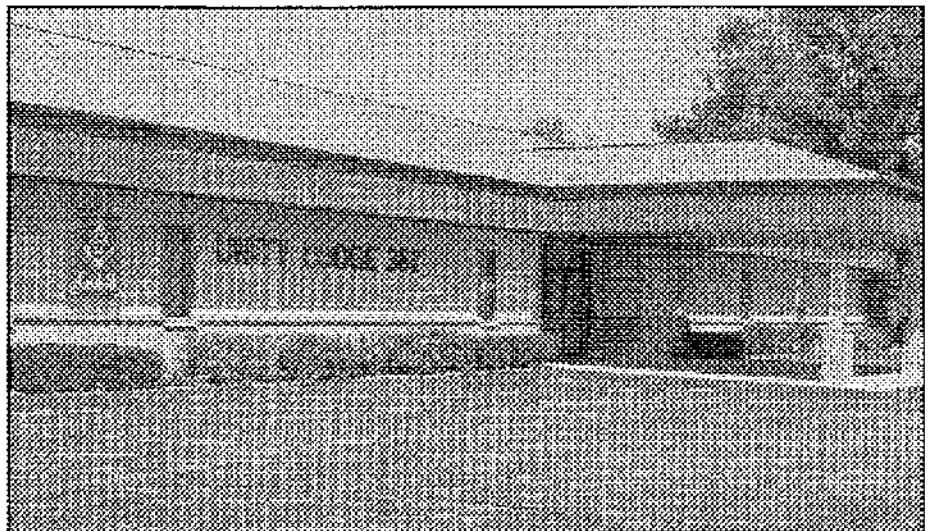
