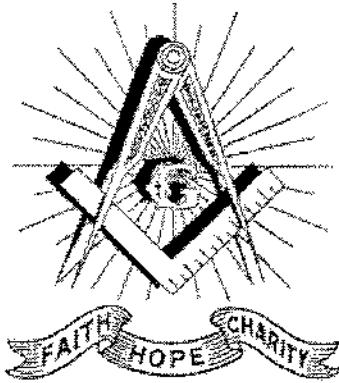

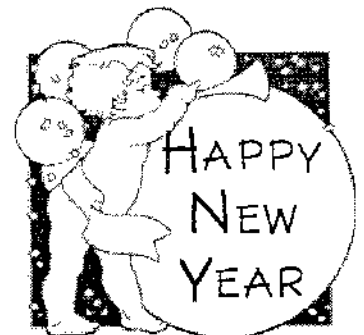
The Lodge will be in good hands for years to come.

2) Our annual Christmas party held on December 16 was a success. Thanks to Brother Royce, our Junior Warden, and to all who assisted in this celebration.

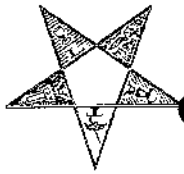
3) Our Trustees have decided to invest our General and Scholarship funds in a short term CD until a final decision can be made as to the best mode of investments for our future growth.

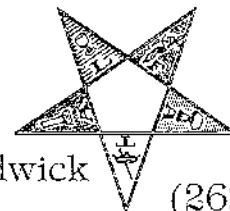
