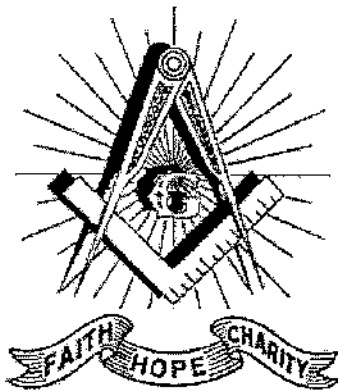

The last Trestleboard listed the names of our elected officers. I would like to introduce our appointed officers.

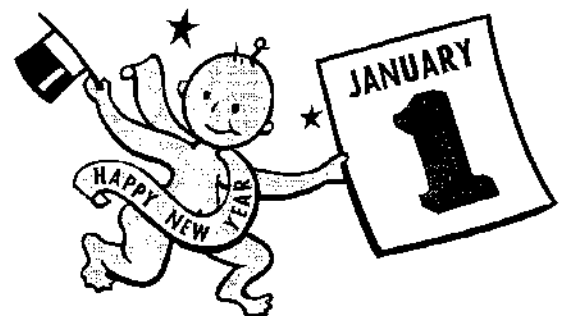

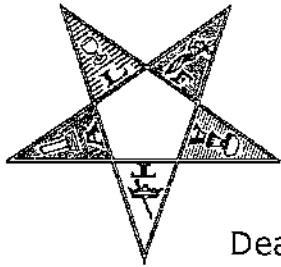

much you enjoy your membership and how much you would enjoy sharing that with them.

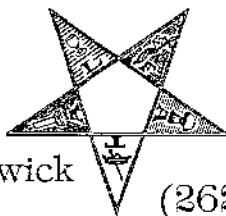
