





No, but we value sacred things and the Holy Writings. In our petition for Membership, the petitioner is asked what Volume of Sacred Law he wants on the Altar as he proceeds in his degrees.

Masons place the Holy Writings as one of our Three Great Lights on the altar at the center of the lodge. They are to guide our thoughts our plans and actions. When we raise a new Mason and give him a copy of his chosen Holy Writing, we refer to it as his Trestle Board.

It is the underpinning for his plans by which he may measure his actions and consider his options in light of the teachings contained therein.

Proverbs 3, Vs. 5,6 tell us, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make straight your paths."

It is basic to Freemasonry that we accept this important teaching as guidance for our daily lives. This coupled with reliance on the power of faith a force strong enough, as described in Matthew 17, to move a mountain and that nothing is impossible.
